## COGNITIVE STRATEGIES } CREATING STRUCTURE FOR INPUT AND OUTPUT

## **TAKING NOTES:**

Writing down the main idea for specific points. This strategy can involve raw notes, or it can comprise a more systematic form of note-taking such as the shopping-list format, the T-formation, the semantic map, or the standard outline form.

## **SUMMARIZING:**

Making a summary or abstract of a longer passage.

## **HIGHLIGHTING:**

Using a variety of emphasis techniques (such as underlining, starring, or colour-coding) to focus on important information in a passage.
