## DIRECT STRATEGIES: SPEAKING

**STRATEGY SET:** Practicing

**STRATEGY:** Repeating

Repeating something in different ways can be a good strategy to learn a foreign language. Repeating something in different ways can be a means of emphasizing it, as in the "tell" "em" rule often used in speaking: "tell 'em what you're going to tell 'em, then tell' em, and then tell 'em what you told 'em. This rule means there is an introduction laying out the main points in greater detail. Imitation of native speakers of the language is one repeating technique for speaking.
