The fifth edition of the UGR's Employment Forum, organised annually by the Employment Agency of the Vice-Rectorate for Student Services and Employability, will be held from 13 to 17 November. The Employment Forum aims to bring the labour market closer to the university community, promoting activities that equip students with the skills required to find employment in increasingly complex labour markets.

The 2017 Employment Forum will put students and graduates from Andalusian universities in direct contact with major national and international employers.
